### LAB TESTS

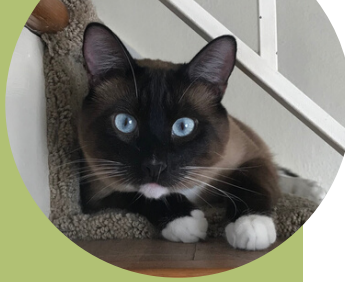

They also screen for genetic and breed-specific health issues and check for chronic conditions like kidney and thyroid disease. Early detection and treatment of chronic disease is critical to helping your cat live a long, healthy life with your family. Early management of chronic or age-related conditions is less costly and risky than emergency treatment once the disease progresses.

### PARASITE TREATMENT

Internal parasites can make your cat seriously ill, but fortunately they are also easy to prevent. Preventive routine deworming against parasites such as roundworm, which can infect humans and cause serious illness, is important to the health of your entire family.

### VACCINATIONS

Vaccinations are an easy way to protect your cat from life-threatening feline illnesses like distemper, while vaccines like rabies protect your whole family because rabies is fatal to both people and pets in your household.
